June 9 — Students with the Last Name beginning with A - M

June 10 — Students with the Last Name beginning with N - Z

Distribution of student items will be from the PC Cafeteria:

- Drive to the **BACK** of the Primary Center to the doors marked CAFETERIA. Please stay in your vehicle and wait for a staff member to greet you.
- After greeting you, a staff member will ask for your child's name and classroom teacher's name. At this time, please return any school items to this staff member.
 - **Items to return: Textbooks, Library Books, We Both Read Books**
- Staff members will take all items into the Primary Center and will return to your vehicle, with your child's belongings. Please remain in your vehicle during this entire process.
- If you have purchased a yearbook, a PTO member will be on site to distribute all pre-purchased yearbooks. A PTO member will bring the yearbook to your vehicle.
- Once you have received your child's items, we ask that you promptly exit the collection line, in order to keep the process moving.

When in the building, please adhere to the following:

- Anyone who enters the building must be wearing a mask or covering over your nose and mouth.
- Please follow all governmental social distancing guidelines.
- In an effort to adhere to governmental social distancing guidelines, the schedule attached has families entering the building by the first letter of their last name. Please adhere to the schedule when coming to retrieve and return items.
- All student items have been bagged and are in either the Cafeteria or gym.
- All classrooms that are located on the lower floor of MAE, which includes Grade 2, as well as, Mrs. Morello and Mr. McCoy's classrooms student items will be in the gym.

- All classrooms that are located on the upper floor of MAE, which includes Grade 4, and remaining Grade 3 classrooms student items will be in the cafeteria.
- The bags are grouped by classroom, and each bag is labeled with the student's name.
- If your child's bag is in the **GYM**, enter through the open gym door and exit through the recess doors.
- If your child's bag is in the **CAFETERIA**, enter through the front doors and exit through the open cafeteria door.
- Place all textbooks on the tables in the gym or cafeteria by grade level.
- If your child's bag is in the cafeteria, return all library books to the library book return bin in the cafeteria.
- If your child's bag is in the gym, return all library books to the table labeled library book return.
- If you have any other district issued materials, please stop in the office to return those items.
- All students who were issued district technology to use during the OCI process will need to return the technology and all related components to the **Centennial School** on **Monday, June 8**. You will not be permitted to retrieve personal items until all technology has been returned.
- Once all items have been retrieved and returned, promptly exit the building.

Hopefully, the 2020-2021 School Year will not be as crazy as this one.

- At each cone, a District staff member will greet you and ask for your student's last name and homeroom. Please return any school items at this time.
 - **Items to return: Textbooks, Library Books, School Owned Items**
- Staff members will take all items into the Centennial School and will return to your vehicle, with your child's belongings. Please remain in your vehicle during this entire process.
