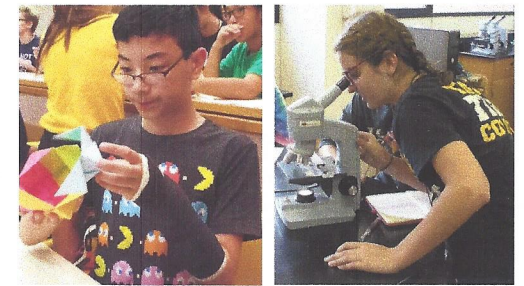
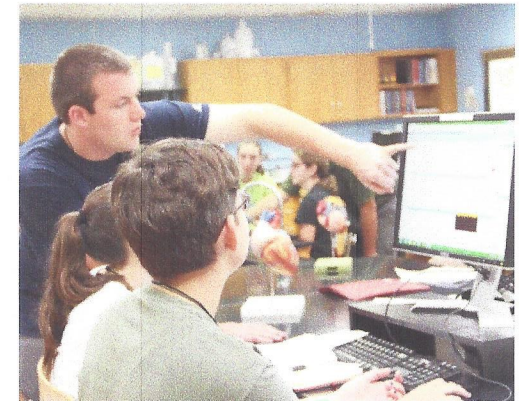

Summer Science Splash Camp is a week-long residential camp on the campus of Westminster College in New Wilmington, PA. Campers can expect a week fully immersed in scientific observations and experiments while exploring innovative technologies in labs and the natural world in sessions led by Westminster faculty and assisted by Westminster students. The fun doesn't stop there! After a thrilling time in the lab, campers can unwind with evening activities such as games, sports, arts, hanging out with new friends and MORE SCIENCE!

Campers do not need to have an advanced understanding of science to attend, but they are highly encouraged to be excited and motivated to learn.

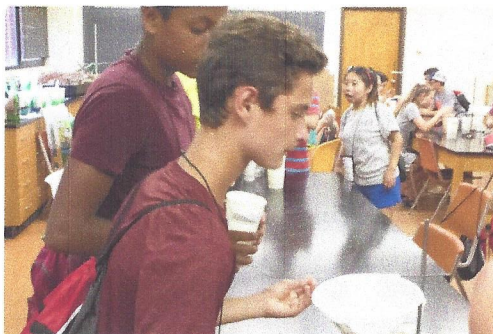
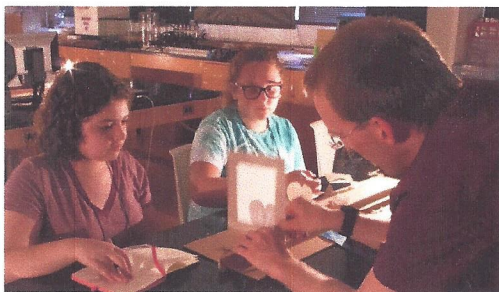
CAMP SESSIONS

Choose from two sessions:

- Session I: July 8 – July 13
- Session II: July 15 – July 20

Campers should arrive Sunday afternoon between 2 p.m. and 3 p.m. and depart Friday afternoon around 2 p.m. Campers will be engaged in team competitions; therefore, campers must stay for the entire week.

Note: Each session provides the same experience, so campers should only register for one session. Registration for both sessions will open in mid-January.



WHO ARE OUR CAMPERS?

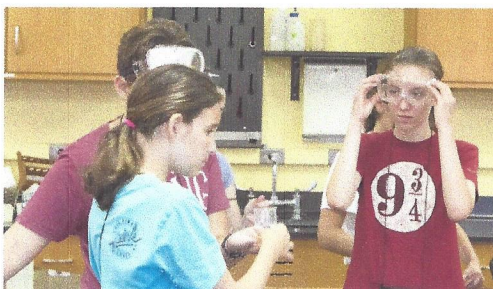
The camp is open to students entering 7th, 8th, or 9th grade in 2018. Sixty campers per session will be grouped into five teams for the week, learning and competing together.

WHO ARE OUR TEACHERS?

Five Westminster College science faculty will lead each group of 12 campers through a set of engaging science activities. Additional staff will support some of the evening activities.

WHO ARE OUR COUNSELORS?

Westminster College students and alumni will assist in each lab session, guide campers around the Westminster College campus, and oversee evening activities with one counselor for every nine campers. A "house parent" will be present in the residence halls with the campers and counselors for some additional adult oversight.



WHO IS THE PERMANENT CAMP STAFF?

- Academic Director: Dr. Craig Caylor, Associate Professor of Physics. Dr. Caylor has been a professor at Westminster since 2001, following his Ph.D. in experimental physics at Cornell University.
- Administrative Assistants: Sharon Muraca and Doreen Matune.

COST
