Mars Area High School Student Council would like to invite you to attend this year's <u>Drive-Thu Trick or Treat Night</u> to be held on **Monday, October 26, 2020**. The Trick or Treating event will open to the public at 5pm and the event will end at 6pm. This event will take place <u>rain or shine!</u>

Since this school year is unique due to COVID-19 safety precautions, Mars High School Student Council is proud to announce that we will be hosting our annual Trick or Treat Night in a new, fun, and safe format...as a Drive-Thru! Rather than the event simply being hosted at the High School and community members proceeding through the hallways to gather their candy and treats, this year's event will help to alleviate crowds, promote social distancing, and assure the safety of all volunteers and community members. Below is an overview of the procedures that community members must follow for the event:

Community members interested in participating in the event will proceed to four of the Mars Area School District Buildings to collect candy. The buildings to be utilized include: **the High School, Middle School, Elementary School, and the Primary Center**. Please note that the Centennial Building will not be utilized in this event. Once arriving at each building, community members are asked to **remain in their cars at all times** throughout Trick or Treating. Mars High School clubs, activities, and sporting teams will be available along the sidewalks at the entrances to each of the buildings to distribute candy to trick or treaters. Community members need only to roll down their windows and the high school students, wearing masks and gloves to promote safety, will hand candy to each little ghost, goblin, and ghoul in your vehicle! After receiving candy at one building, your trick or treating fun continues as you proceed to visit the high school students at the next building! Please note that a map of the Trick or Treat Route will be posted to the district website on **Friday, October 23rd** as a resource.

While Trick or Treat Night is a fun event geared towards celebrating Halloween, Student Council also strives to make this an event in which we can **make a difference in our community**. We would greatly appreciate your support in **donating canned food items** for the St. Killian sponsored **Food Pantry that is centered in Mars Borough**, which provides food to those in need within the Mars Area School District.
